INTRODUCTION

DELIVERANCE TO DESTINY

Ind it very interesting that the first public sermon preached by our Lord Jesus Christ, and particularly among devout religious folks, was a message on deliverance. Hear the words of our Lord from Luke 4:18, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised."
